H.G. Bishop Anba Daniel – Bishop and Abbot of St. Shenouda Monastery, Sydney, Australia

Early Life:

- Born: October 10, 1952 in Khartoum, Sudan
- Immigrated to Sydney, Australia with family on August 7, 1970
- Studied Accountancy in Sydney, completed in 1972

Spiritual Path:

- Served as a Deacon and youth leader in Sydney
- In 1978, traveled to Egypt to pursue monastic life at St. Anthony Monastery

Ordinations:

- Became a Monk: April 8, 1979
- Ordained a Priest: May 1979
- Elevated to Hegomen: May 1980
- All ordinations by H.H. Pope Shenouda III

Service in Australia:

- Returned in 1980 to serve in multiple Coptic churches across Australia
- Served in Melbourne, Sydney, Perth, Canberra, Brisbane, Adelaide, and Tasmania

St. Shenouda Monastery:

- Land acquired in 1993, monastic life began in 1995
- Took charge in 2006
- Ordained Bishop on June 7, 2009
- Officially recognized by Australian Parliament in 2011

Duties and Contributions:

- Official spokesperson and representative
- Manages all financial, administrative, and legal affairs
- Founder of “Pi Monakhos” youth newsletter
- Oversees youth retreats, book translation, and spiritual programs

A lifelong servant of Christ, H.G. Bishop Daniel has contributed greatly to the growth and stability of the Coptic Orthodox Church in Australia.
